



As per New York State Department of Health guidance distributed on March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022, the following is our updated Park Creek Visitation Policy

Park Creek now has permission to “provide immediate access to any resident’s visitors of their choice including, but not limited to, immediate family or other relatives of the resident and any other visitors, with the consent of the resident.

The following are guidelines for this policy in adherence with the DOH guidance:

- While it is safer not to enter the building if there is a Covid-19 outbreak, visitors are allowed.
- Regardless of vaccination status, visitors are required to wear face masks.
- Visits should be in a resident’s room unless otherwise approved by the Administrator.
- Hand hygiene, that is, washing with soap and water, should be performed prior to visiting a resident.
- Visitors are asked to maintain physical distancing from other residents and staff.
- Visitors who have a positive viral test for Covid-19 or are symptomatic, should not visit Park Creek.
- Park Creek will not limit the number of visitors a resident may have nor the frequency and lengths of visits.
- Visitors no longer need to schedule their visits.
- As appropriate physical distancing must still be maintained, large gatherings will still be restricted.
- Compassionate care visitors are allowed at all times.
- Park Creek may ask a visitor of their vaccination status. With that said, visitors are not required to be tested or vaccinated or show proof of vaccination to visit.
- If a resident is going to leave Park Creek for longer than 24 hours, please contact Geri or Natalie for further information on the return to our community policy.
